Description

Pen, brown ink, and brown wash on paper. A fine full-length study of a male figure dressed in 18th-century fashion: a long buttoned coat, breeches, stockings, and shoes. Standing with a slight shift in weight, the young man strikes a natural, elegant pose, with one hand resting on his chest and the other hanging at his side. The drawing is distinguished by the freedom and confidence of its linework, particularly evident in the rendering of the face, hands, and the folds of the clothing. The brown wash, applied in broad strokes, defines volume and shadow while preserving the sheet's spontaneous quality. In the background, a few rapidly sketched pieces of furniture place the figure within an interior setting without distracting attention from the subject himself. An old handwritten inscription, "N°
