The combination of warm copper and golden-toned brass gives the piece a particularly attractive and decorative presence. The copper displays the subtle irregularities, surface marks and variations in color associated with age and traditional use, creating a rich, authentic patina. The brass handles are securely attached with copper rivets, while the three raised feet give the colander an elegant silhouette as well as allowing it to stand
