Large embroidered textile panel depicting Shou Lao, the Chinese god of longevity. The figure is depicted as a bearded old man with a prominent forehead, holding a long staff. The design is rendered on a black textile background, which particularly highlights the colors of the threads and the finesse of the work. The details of the costume, the outlines, and the geometric motifs attest to beautiful decorative work, likely executed in silk threads or a silk blend.
