Two Fountain Heads depicting Bacchus-style heads crowned with bunches of grapes, made of plaster from the late 19th century. A superb decorative piece from the late 19th century depicting two heads of bearded men crowned with laurel leaves and grapes, their mouths open in the style of ancient theatrical masks and forming fountain spouts framed by vine stocks and branches, as well as leaves and bunches of grapes. Bacchus, the god of the vine; Dionysus; Bacchanalia; fauns and satyrs--likely allegorical figures associated with the god Bacchus. A plaster sculpture with a patina resembling terracotta. A late 19th-century plaster sculpture in high relief and in perfect condition. Styled after ancient theatrical masks and fountain spouts, this is an unusual sculpture with a very strong presence.
