Description

Pair of oak armchairs with leather seats and backs. There are no markings that would allow them to be attributed to any specific designer, but their design and architectural character suggest that they are likely Dutch furniture. Indeed, one can sense the spirit of The Hague's modernist school, with designers such as Frits Spanjaard and Cor Alons as its precursors. However, this is a more recent work (from the 1970s/1980s) that can be likened to the work of Wim Mulder.
