It features a rich and complex checkerboard pattern, with a beautiful scalloped border. Ideal for a festive dining table, a curtain, or a decorative panel. The dimensions are large for an extremely intricate tablecloth: 160 cm wide by 265 cm long. It is in very good condition; everything--the linen, the fabric, the embroidery, and the lace--is entirely handmade. An incredible masterpiece of patience and precision! This tablecloth was likely made in the late 19th or early 20th century, between 1890 and 1930.
