English wine funnel Bearing a coat of arms from the George IV era, it is made of 925 sterling silver with a lion passant hallmark, dated 1823 by the letter H, made in London with a leopard's head hallmark the silversmith's mark is CF Charles Fox II weight 159.5 g note: a few small dents, a slight deformation on the rim and the underside of the funnel has a repaired weld that is not visible and does not prevent its use A very beautiful piece for a wine tasting with friends.
