Description

In *Forest in Late Autumn*, painted in 1903 by Yuliy Klever, the artist evokes the solemn poetry of nature's decline--majestic, silent, and profound. The light of the full moon cuts through the autumn mist, turning the tops of the firs and birches silver, gliding along the moss-covered trunks, and illuminating a fallen tree, frozen as if in a final gesture of farewell. Amid this silence, a stir: a pair of wild boars makes its way through the fallen leaves, bringing life and movement to the forest's almost suspended breath. The work is executed in Klever's characteristic late style--with subtle transitions between cool and warm tones, layered play of light, and a meditative stillness that invites introspection.
