Description

Study of Bernhard Keilhau (Helsingør, 1624 - Rome, 1687) Young Gardeners Oil on canvas, 92 x 71.5 The work is attributed to Bernhard Keil, a painter of Danish origin who moved to Italy in 1651 (Venice, Lombardy, Romagna, Rome), where he introduced a folk-inspired naturalism that would inspire the genre scenes of the leading northern painters of the early 18th century, including Crespi, Ceruti, Todeschini, and Amorosi. Keil's body of work is characterized by depictions of figures from the humblest social classes, often serving as a vehicle for allegorical meanings linked to the seasons, the senses, the elements, and the stages of human life. There are two other versions of the painting on display that have appeared on the antique market: one at Pandolfini in Florence on November 28, 2013,
