Description

An elegant pair of candlesticks in mercury-gilded bronze and white-veined griotte marble, a French piece from the second half of the 19th century. Each piece features a fluted red marble shaft, framed by finely chiseled mounts decorated with acanthus leaves and beaded collars, typical of the Louis XVI ornamental style revisited during the reign of Napoleon III. The circular bases, also in griotte marble, rest on three small bronze feet and are accented with a gilded border. The original gilding has developed a warm, nuanced patina, reflecting the traditional process of fire gilding. There is a small, discreet chip at the base that does not affect the stability or overall beauty of the piece. Refined, balanced, and decorative craftsmanship, ideal for a console table, a desk, or a mantelpiece. Height: 26.5
