Description

The Gorges, a mountain landscape populated by figures from the Restoration period, circa 1830. In the foreground, a group of fishermen stands near a mountain stream. To carry out their work, they are equipped with a wicker trap and a net. On the right, a carriage carrying fodder travels along a narrow, winding mountain path, leaving a thick cloud of dust in its wake. In the background, two figures walk along the same path at the foot of an imposing mountain surrounded by clouds. Oil on paper mounted on canvas. This painting is presented in its original frame. Canvas dimensions : 52 cm x 35.5 cm / Dimensions with frame : 64.5 cm x 48 cm A few minor imperfections are worth noting : small cracks and old restorations.
