A beautiful 19th-century Normandy cabinet, particularly striking for the richness and delicacy of its carved decoration. It opens with two large doors lavishly adorned with floral and foliage motifs. The upper section is adorned with a very pretty floral basket carved in relief, while the doors feature numerous floral and foliage motifs as well as medallions, lending the piece great charm and elegance. It features a very attractive bluish-gray patina, enhanced by delicate cream-colored repainting that highlights the carvings and adds great depth to the design. Close-up photographs allow one to best appreciate the true color of the patina as well as the nuances of the repainting. One of this cabinet's greatest strengths also lies in its particularly appealing dimensions. Unlike many Norman

cabinets, which are often very tall and imposing, this one has proportions that are much easier to incorporate into an interior. At 209 cm tall and only 127 cm wide, it will fit just as well in a living room as in an entryway or bedroom. Dimensions: height 209 cm - width 127 cm - depth 50 cm.
