Description

Elegant decorative glazed ceramic bowl by Louis Dage, circa 1930, set in a beautiful gilded metal mount with foliage motifs. The bowl features an unusual enamel decoration in complex shades of blue-green-grey, deeply veined with craquelure, with a central motif in shades of red, brown, cream, and yellow, creating a very rich and nuanced effect. The particularly decorative mount consists of a beaded border and two leaf-shaped side ornaments, resting on a small base with a plant motif. Signed L. Dage. A particularly decorative piece, characteristic of Louis Dage's experiments with glazes and textural effects. In very good condition. Dimensions: diameter approximately 18 cm; height 5.5 cm. Louis Dage (1885-1963), was French ceramic artist renowned for his experiments with glazes, textural effects,

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and richly colored decorations. His work evolved from the naturalism of Art Nouveau toward the more stylized aesthetic of Art Deco. He is particularly appreciated for the originality of his glazes and surface effects.
