A true testament to the past, this wrought-iron harpoon, known as a "Foëne," is a product of 19th-century French folk craftsmanship, used for fishing in ponds and rivers in Charente-Maritime. This fishing tool could be used to catch certain species such as bass, carp, and pike; fishermen of that era fished in shallow rivers dotted with rocks.
