Ancient Chinese bronze sculpture depicting a shepherd on a water buffalo. Patinated bronze statuette, cast in bronze, depicting a shepherd playing the flute while riding a water buffalo. Its hollow structure and surface irregularities clearly indicate that this sculpture was created using the lost-wax casting technique. In Chinese art and Zen philosophy, a boy riding a water buffalo is a highly prized allegorical theme. It symbolizes harmony with nature, the simple joys of rural life, and the Zen concept of taming the mind. 12 cm wide, 5 cm deep, and 11 cm high. Total weight: 386 grams.
