We are selling this solid silver parliamentary identification medal, often referred to as an attendance token or voting badge. It weighs 63.51 g and has a diameter of approximately 50 mm. Struck by the Monnaie de Paris for the Senate of the Third Republic. Dated 1876 and attributed to a senator named Henry Varroy (1826-1883). A civil engineer by training and a native of the Moselle department, he served as a minister under the Third Republic and was thus appointed to the Senate in 1876. "Argent" marked on the edge.
