The Montbaron Gallery is honored to present this magnificent early 20th-century heraldic *repostero*, a large-scale textile work with an imposing presence, proudly displaying the rosette-shaped coat of arms of the "Twelve Lineages" of Soria (*Doce Linajes de Soria*). A true monument to the glory of ancient lineages and noble ancestry, this piece embodies the austere, almost mystical conceptual reality of Soria--a land where the rugged terrain and centuries of history converge to create an enduring romantic and medieval resonance. Far from being merely a decorative element, this *repostero* stands as a profound visual manifesto of the Spanish nobility's tenacious obsession with lineage, ancestry, and chivalric honor, echoing a mythical past even a millennium after the dawn

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of the Reconquista. Rendering the complex heraldic architecture of the *Doce Linajes* with remarkable graphic precision, the composition places the monarch at the center, surrounded by the coats of arms of the founding families in a tight, radial harmony. The palette of deep, subdued colors and the solemn geometry reflect the stoic spirit of the Castilian tradition, evoking the legendary knights who once guarded the kingdom's borders.
