Description

Chinese desk made of brick-red lacquered wood, featuring four drawers along the front with openwork metal half-moon pulls, resting on square-section legs joined by a wide, low openwork shelf. The back of the drawer band is left unfinished. The piece shows signs of normal wear, scattered chips in the lacquer, and scratches on the top and edges, as well as a repair on the crossbar. H. 78.5 cm - W. 114.8 cm - D. 57.4 cm Accompanied by a chair made of red-lacquered wood with gilded accents and a curved, openwork backrest. The central panel of the backrest features two relief-carved medallions on a red lacquered background; one is adorned with a foliage scroll motif, and the other depicts a lively scene of a scholar and his assistant. The solid, square-sectioned seat rests on a straight

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base joined by crossbars, topped at the front by a low, discreetly cut apron. The piece exhibits a pronounced patina of use, including chipped lacquer, surface wear, areas where the gilding is missing, and scattered scratches, while retaining a sound and stable structure.H. 94.7 cm - Seat: 50.7 cm - W. 39 cm
