Description

A rare Piedmontese armchair in polychrome wood dating from the late 15th century, characterized by an architectural structure and an impressive set of heraldic decorations. The tall backrest is centered by a carved panel bearing a coat of arms in relief, framed by painted geometric elements and vertical posts. The armrests, with their clean lines, are set within a wooden frame that retains a polychrome finish in shades of red, blue, ochre, and beige. The padded seat, upholstered in fabric, completes the piece. The presence of the coat of arms and the monumental character of the backrest give the armchair a strong decorative identity. An interesting example of late 15th-century Piedmontese furniture, notable for its age, polychromy, and heraldic decoration.
