Description

An elegant 19th-century tabernacle made of painted and gilded wood, characterized by a classical-style architectural composition. The front features an arched door framed by two pairs of ebony-stained columns with gilded capitals. The structure is embellished with moldings, carved motifs, and gilded details, while the surfaces, painted in shades of soft green, light blue, and ivory, create a refined chromatic contrast with the dark columns. The upper portion is crowned by a prominent projecting cornice with architectural decorations, while the shaped and molded base lends solidity and a monumental appearance to the whole. An interesting example of 19th-century sacred art and ecclesiastical furnishings.
