Description

The painting "Water Lilies (Nymphéas)" by D.A. Litchenko, created in 1925, is a poetic and refined depiction of the harmony of nature. The composition unfolds on the calm surface of a pond, where, bathed in sunlight, pure white water lily buds bloom, surrounded by large emerald-green leaves. The artist masterfully captures the blue and turquoise reflections on the water, which gently mirror the sky. The impasto technique creates a tactile texture in the petals and foliage, enhancing the sense of presence. The painting is presented in a large gilded frame adorned with rich moldings, emphasizing the work's classical aesthetic.
