An elegant, all-around barbière made of mahogany and mahogany veneer, with a white marble cabaret-style top (minor restorations at two corners and small chips); the marble top can be moved to reveal a tilting mirror, adjustable in height via a rack-and-pinion system, surmounting two small side drawers and a niche with two fluted columns and a white marble top, opening via three drawers in the lower section (with a key) and resting on four tapered legs ending with casters (minor signs of age). Louis XVI period. Good condition.
