An important heraldic frieze in red marble, created in the 17th century, depicting a noble coat of arms finely carved. The remarkable depth of the sculpture, approximately 17 cm, gives the frieze a strong three-dimensional presence and underscores the architectural character of the work, which was most likely originally intended to decorate a building or a ceremonial space.
