Description

A full-color silkscreen print titled *Marilyn*, based on one of the most iconic images associated with Andy Warhol (1928-1987), the renowned American artist and a major figure in 20th-century Pop Art. The composition reinterprets the iconic portrait of Marilyn Monroe, which Warhol transformed into a symbol of mass culture, cinematic myth, and the new visual language of postwar America. Through the use of silkscreen printing, the artist reinterprets the principles of the serial image, advertising, and the media, blurring the boundaries between fine art and popular culture. The work is part of a limited edition of 250 copies. This print is numbered 94/250. The reverse bears the inscription: "Marilyn. Sunday B Morning. Fill in your own signature." Inscriptions:
