An Empire-period barber's chair in flamed mahogany, resting on square spindle legs. The top, featuring fold-down wings and a gallery, conceals a basin and a sliding mirror held in place by a bronze push-button locking mechanism. The central door is adorned with a gilded bronze appliqué featuring a flying eagle amid foliage--an emblematic motif of the style. It opens to reveal an interior organized into two drawers with ring handles and two shelves. The side panels feature friezes of chiseled gilt-bronze palmettes.
