Imposing pistol with two superimposed octagonal barrels featuring a rocker arm pivot for the swiveling slide rod, which is housed beneath the barrels. Double-trigger mechanism under the trigger guard and rear-mounted lock plate with remnants of engraving; the mechanism is in working order. Walnut stock featuring a brass thumb rest on the back and a mechanical cap with a keypad concealing the primer reservoir. Muzzle caliber of the barrels: 15 mm. Length: 38 cm. Barrel length: 22 cm.
