Description

A lively street scene in ink and wash on paper titled "The Two Classes of Whites." It depicts a dandy in a top hat holding a greyhound on a leash, facing a porter bent under his load, rendered in a caricature-like style. Signed "G. Doré" in the lower right corner and dated 1848. The technique--ink, gray wash, and highlights on tinted paper--is characteristic of Gustave Doré's early works; at the time, he was 16 years old and likely just beginning his career contributing to the Journal pour rire. Presented under glass, framed.
