Description

Set of three framed fans: -French fan from the Victorian era or mid-19th century (between 1840 and 1870). Openwork bone sticks, delicately adorned with small painted floral cartouches (medallions). The center of the leaf features a lively scene with a group of figures in a landscape, while the sides display superb gilded geometric and floral patterns. - Fan from the late 18th or early 19th century, with openwork bone sticks and a leaf decorated with scenes of figures in a landscape. - Fan from Canton, China (19th century). Sticks: Black and gold lacquered wood or bamboo (fundame-style technique or similar), finely decorated with scenes of figures in garden or pavilion settings. Leaf: Gouache-painted paper depicting scenes of festivities, terraces, or courtyards with numerous figures (often referred

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to as a "Mandarin" or "thousand-face" fan).
