Rare charlotte mold made of embossed copper featuring the profile of Emperor Napoleon III. This type of mold, popular throughout the 19th century, was used to make various sweet and savory dishes, but also served a decorative--and, in this case, even political--purpose. Well-crafted from embossed copper to reproduce the Emperor's profile in uniform, this mold was likely made by a Parisian manufacturer such as Trottier but bears no markings. In very good overall condition, with a small crack on the body, visible in the zoomed-in details in the photos. Height: 15 cm, diameter: 20 cm. Second Empire period.
