Luxurious sewing kit Presented in a case covered in red- and gold-dyed long-grain morocco leather. Gold filigree decorations. Inside the lid is a mirror; a silk pad protects the tray of tools. This set includes 6 gold or gold-mounted tools: 1 pair of scissors, 1 needle holder, 1 thimble, 1 pencil holder, 1 pendant-style smelling salts bottle, and 1 yarn needle that doubles as a toothpick and ear pick. All pieces are made of 18-karat gold, with a Paris guarantee. The scissors and needle holder bear the hallmark of Parisian master goldsmith Antoine Beauvisage. Total weight of the pieces excluding the bottle: 29 g. Paris, c. 1810 In good condition, with some minor wear; the protective cushion is unstitched and stained.
