J. Douzon - The Eve of Battle: Austerlitz or Waterloo? - 1900 Watercolor and ink on paper, signed "J. Douzon" in the lower left and dated "1900" in the lower right. This humorous and satirical composition depicts Napoleon I on horseback, scanning the horizon through a telescope, accompanied by several caricatured military figures, in front of a marching army. The scene features numerous unusual details, including a balloon in the sky, a figure carrying a crate of dynamite, and a building bearing the inscription "Rue de Charonne." The work is titled "La Veillée d'armes - Austerlitz or Waterloo?", referring to the two famous Napoleonic battles. A humorous drawing, rendered with expressive brushwork and delicate colors, reflecting the spirit of French caricature from the late 19th and
