Rena Dumas and Hermès Paris Folding side table "Pippa" Paris, c. 1985 Pear wood, brass; marked on the table frame: "HERMÈS/PARIS" 49.5 x 61 x 61.5 cm Designed by Rena Dumas and Peter Coles, this folding line embodies the art of travel and movement so dear to the house. The subtle combination of fine wood essences and high-quality leathers offers a perfect balance between suppleness, strength and refinement. The Pippa collection, designed by Rena Dumas (with Peter Coles) for Hermès, dates from the 1980s -- this collection of "nomadic" furniture signed by Rena Dumas. Rena Dumas (1937-2009), a Greek interior architect, founded her agency RDAI (Rena Dumas Architecture Intérieure) in Paris in 1972, before becoming the dedicated designer for Hermès stores worldwide.
