Description The paintings are covered with a silver oklad that has been repoussé, chased, and engraved, revealing the faces and hands. Oval setting topped with a twisted ring. Several Imperial Russian hallmarks, including the 84 zolotniki fineness mark, corresponding to 875/1000 silver, as well as a hallmark inscribed "?? 1811," which dates the piece to 1811. There is also a small additional hallmark. Imperial Russia, 1811. 84 zolotniki silver (875/1000) with under-klad painting. Weight: 56 g. Dimensions: 8.5 × 6.5 cm. Condition Beautiful patina and signs of age-related wear consistent with its age and use
