Description

An elegant French Art Nouveau folding screen dating from the early twentieth century, crafted as a two-panel room divider with a striking black lacquered ground. The surface is hand-painted with graceful iris blossoms and elongated foliage, rendered in rich shades of crimson, gold, olive green, and cream. The floral composition rises organically across both panels, reflecting the movement's fascination with nature and sinuous botanical forms. The screen's gently undulating top edge enhances its sculptural silhouette, while the deep black lacquer provides a dramatic backdrop that accentuates the vibrant hand-painted decoration. Both practical and decorative, this piece serves beautifully as a room divider, firescreen, or accent panel, bringing a refined Art Nouveau presence to an

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interior. Presented in good vintage condition, with minor wear and light losses to the painted decoration consistent with age and use, contributing to its authentic period character.
