Description

A charming Swedish rustic stool crafted in solid pine, dating from the early twentieth century. Defined by its simple yet expressive construction, the piece features broad trestle-form legs with decorative cut-out arches and a central stretcher that provides both stability and visual balance. The warm honey-toned pine has developed a rich patina over decades of use, highlighting the natural grain and understated beauty of the material. Its honest craftsmanship and utilitarian character embody the enduring appeal of Scandinavian vernacular furniture, where functionality and simplicity take precedence over ornament. Compact and versatile, the stool can be used as occasional seating, a small side table, a plant stand, or as an accent piece within both rustic and contemporary

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interiors. The sculptural silhouette created by the angled supports and cut-out details lends the piece a strong architectural presence despite its modest scale. Presented in good vintage condition, with normal signs of age and use that contribute to its authentic character and appeal.
