Description

This Bocage-style bookcase from Maison Regain, dating from the 1970s, features an XXL design. Entirely crafted from solid blond elm, this freestanding unit features an open-shelf system that allows for complete modularity. The various storage units and shelves can be precisely adjusted and positioned at the desired height on sturdy uprights by simply slotting them into place. The storage units and shelves naturally interlock and lock into place at 7.5-cm intervals. The bookcase is available in two modules; this is the first option. With a span of nearly four linear meters, this architectural piece covers an entire wall while maintaining a sense of visual lightness thanks to a unique, asymmetrical interplay of depth--an effect created by alternating shelf depths of 46 and 34 cm. module 244 cm long and 225 cm high, with shelf depths varying between 46 and 34 cm. Second module: 154 cm long, 225 cm high, with the same shelf depths. The set consists of a three-drawer chest, a bar or desk, two two-door storage units, two single-door units, and ten shelves. It can be completely disassembled and is in excellent condition.
