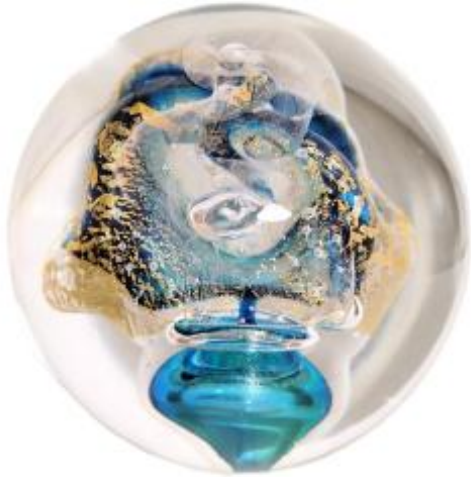




Robert Pierini (1950) Sulfure / Magnum Blown Glass Paperweight, 1994

Description

A stunning and significant spherical sulfur-colored piece crafted from mouth-blown crystal/art glass, created in 1994 by the renowned French master glassmaker Robert PIERINI (born in 1950) in his historic studio in Biot (Alpes-Maritimes). This one-of-a-kind collector's piece showcases the artist's virtuosity in creating layered decorative elements. It features a complex abstract biomorphic design composed of blue pigment inclusions (cobalt and turquoise) encased within a spiral of transparent glass, all enhanced by lavish splashes of precious gold leaf flakes and fine, controlled air bubbles. The magnifying effect and the density of the crystal lend this piece a magnificent depth and luminous reflections that shift depending on the lighting. Engraved with a needle under the base: "R. Pierini 1994,"
