A magnificent piece of blown glass art with a slender shape (obelisk or teardrop-like), mouth-blown glass, featuring the Sommerso technique. This contemporary work showcases superb technical mastery: a core of elongated motifs evoking flames or plant forms in vivid red, blue, and opaque white tones, delicately suspended and frozen within a block of highly pure, transparent glass. The piece rests on a magnificent base inlaid with gold flakes (gold leaf shattered within the mass), creating a unique sparkle and a striking contrast with the purity of the transparent glass. The piece is hand-signed "Laurent" on the base and dated "2006" (see photos). Height: 19 cm Width: 6 cm Weight: 1 kg. Éric Laurent (1959-2018) was a renowned French master glassmaker and sculptor.
