Description

This Rolex GMT-Master, reference 16750 "Pepsi", dating from 1982, is a remarkable example of a vintage Rolex sports watch, particularly sought after for its matte black tritium dial, its iconic red and blue bezel, and its set of period accessories. The dial, marked SWISS - T < 25, features beautiful tritium hour markers that have developed a warm, even cream-colored patina over the course of more than forty years. This natural patina gives this Rolex GMT-Master 16750 all the character prized by collectors of vintage Rolex watches. It retains its original Rolex case, reference 16750, and is fitted with a Rolex Oyster bracelet, reference 78360, with 589 end links. Its serial number, intentionally partially obscured in the listing for security reasons, begins with 7,25X,XXX, a numbering consistent with its

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production period. The particular appeal of this Rolex GMT-Master 16750 Pepsi also lies in the quality of its provenance and overall condition. Purchased at the end of November 1982, it comes with its Rolex case, its official chronometer certification, its numbered Rolex tag, its calendar, and various period accessories. The numbered items correspond to the watch's individual serial number, further enhancing the appeal of this set for a collector. The 16750 model holds a special place in the history of the GMT-Master. It retains the aesthetic of previous generations while featuring an automatic movement with quick-set date, a significant advancement over the previous generation. The watch is in nice vintage condition, with normal signs of age and use. A few micro-scratches are particularly visible on the bracelet clasp. The dial, the patina, and the various signs of aging fully contribute to the authentic character of this watch, which is over forty years old. A Rolex GMT-Master 16750 "Pepsi" with a tritium dial, accompanied by such a complete and consistent set of components, is today a particularly appealing piece for the vintage Rolex enthusiast seeking character, provenance, and history.
