Circular base made of blown glass in a deep, opaque cobalt blue, providing a strong and stable visual foundation for the lamp. The lampshade and base light up together, creating a unique, warm, and colorful ambiance. Signed at the tip beneath the base: "Pascal Guyot 203." In perfect aesthetic and working condition. No chips, cracks, or restoration. Original electrical wiring in perfect working order. High-end contemporary design
