An architectural panel in high relief depicting Shiva Nataraja performing the Ananda Tandava, the cosmic dance, from Tamil Nadu in southern India and dated to around 1900. Carved from a single slab of solid hardwood, it depicts Shiva in a ritual composition intended for use in the architecture of a Hindu temple. The attributes and gestures follow the iconography of the dancing Shiva. The original surface shows a patina, wear, and losses consistent with its age. Condition consistent with an antique architectural element, with visible signs of use and wear. Dimensions: length 107 cm; height 107 cm; depth not specified. Weight: 17 kg. Reference: SKU 701.
