



Stuffed Birds In A Frame With A Curved Glass Pane

Description

Two taxidermied bird specimens mounted on black velvet, signed in red "Ledot Jne," set in an oval frame of molded oak with domed glass, comprising a specimen from the family Alcedinidae of the species known as the Senegal Kingfisher-hunter from Senegal, and a specimen from the family Scolopacidae of the species known as the Spotted Sandpiper (*Calidris pugnax*) or, synonymously, *Philomachus pugnax*. On the back of the frame is an old stamp from the taxidermy workshop indicating the 1878 World's Fair. Specializing in taxidermied birds for dining rooms: LEDOT Jne, 212 and 214 Rue de Rivoli, Paris.
