### Description

An elegant pair of Chinese wooden armchairs from the Qing dynasty, dating from 1797-1820, characterized by a refined structure and rich decoration in the Oriental style. The frame features contoured, flowing armrests, straight legs connected by crossbars, and a front panel finely decorated with ornamental motifs in the Chinese style. The seats are made of original woven straw, with the frame and fastening system visible on the underside. The armchairs have been restored and are solid and in excellent condition.
