An interesting Baoulé gong (lawle), richly carved and mounted on a pedestal. On the hammer side, the cloth used to dampen the impact of the wood is still present, along with a carved head likely depicting an ancestor, and in the middle of the handle, another carved figure that appears to be singing or whistling. Beautiful patina. First half to mid-20th century. Formerly in a private Belgian collection. Length approximately 27 cm. Fast and careful shipping. Fast and careful shipping within 48 hours. Worldwide shipping, except to the U.S. for the time being, due to customs duties and clearance complications.
