This family from Marseille, during the 18th century, manufactured and sold all kinds of compasses, azimuth compasses, and other instruments, hourglasses of various types, sextants, ninety-degree octants, sighting rods, telescopes, achromatic telescopes of various lengths, night vision glasses, and other items... in the harbor near Saint Jean.
