Description

A collectible hand-blown glass bottle, created by French master glassmaker Éric Laurent (1959-2018). This one-of-a-kind piece was created at the renowned Verrerie d'Allex (Drôme), showcasing the artist's remarkable craftsmanship before he founded his own studio in 1991. The bottle features stunning shades of pink integrated into the body of the glass, beautifully capturing the light with the reflections and organic patterns characteristic of free-form glassblowing. The bottle comes with its original stopper (marked "Allex 90"). Height: 14.50 cm × Width/Depth: 9.50 cm. **ÉRIC LAURENT** (1959/2018) began his apprenticeship in glassmaking at age 15 at the Allex glassworks. After seven years of traditional glassmaking, he became a glass artist and founded his own studio.
