Description

This magnificent landscape, depicting deer by a forest stream, is the work of the famous German landscape and animal painter Heinrich Böhmer (1852-Düsseldorf-1930). The father of the painter H. Böhmer, he studied at the Düsseldorf Academy from 1876 to 1882, then was a student of Eugen Dücker until 1884. He produced numerous forest landscapes in oil as well as views of the Eifel, the Harz, the Vogel Mountains, and the Odenwald. His works are housed in the Wiesbaden Museum.
