Description

An elegant and imposing bronze statue with a brown patina depicting a young cherub musician, shown seated and playing the transverse flute. The putto has a full head of hair adorned with leaves and clusters of fruit, rendered with remarkable attention to detail. The modeling of the body, hands, face, and drapery attests to the high quality of the craftsmanship. The dark, nuanced patina particularly highlights the sculpture's reliefs. The figure rests on a circular base of griotte red marble, accented by a gilded bronze molding, lending the piece a particularly refined decorative presence. A striking ensemble, characteristic of the decorative taste of the Second Empire, blending Neo-Baroque sculpture with luxurious materials. A particularly decorative piece, suitable for a collector's home as well as for display in a

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library or living room.
