Description

Pablo PICASSO. This *Tête de Faune* (Head of a Faun) by Pablo Picasso is an original linocut printed at the Arnera workshops in Vallauris in 1955. It is signed in the plate. An edition of 450 copies was originally produced, but virtually all have disappeared given their intended use. This is a rare linocut actually carved by the artist himself--unlike his many posters, which were often based on existing drawings or produced by the Mourlot workshops. Presented on 80 x 60 cm paper in a light wood frame. REFERENCES: Czwiklitzer catalogue raisonné #17; Bloch catalogue raisonné #1267.
