Carved and gilded wood "francesina" frame.
Venice, 18th century. Sight 56 x 73.5 cm - Rebate 54 x 71.5 cm - Overall 64 x 81.5 cm. Carved and gilded wood frame of the type known as "francesina". The outer edge is carved with a twisted ribbon motif. Next comes a broad, plain, rounded central band, with carved elements at the corners and at the centre of each side. Towards the sight edge the profile ends in a fillet of fine beading. The water gilding has a warm tone, with the red bole showing through where it is most worn. Condition report: Overall good state of preservation, with signs of age and wear to the gilding, including minor losses and abrasions.
